


THE ASS M AMUSEMENTS AND BETTING TAX (AME DMENT) ACT, 1995

> AN. ACT

further to amend the Assam Amusements and Assam Act Betting Tax Act, 1939.

Preamble.

Whereas it is expedient further to amend the Assam Amusements and Betting Tax Act, 1939, hereinafter referred to as the principal Act in the manner hereinafter appearing;

It is hereby enacted in the Forty-sixth Year of the Republic of India as follows:

Short title, exte t and commencement.

- 1. (1) This Act may be called the Assam Amusements and Betting Tax (Amendment) Act, 1995.
- (2) It shall have the like extent as the principal Act.
- (3) It shall come into force at nee

Insertion of (b) in section 3.

- 2. In the principal Act, in section 3, in subnew clause section (1), after clause (a), the following shall b inserted as clause (b) and the existing clauses (b) aid (c) snall be recumbered as clause (c) and (d) respictively, namely:-
 - "(b) In the case of cinematograph exhibition, where the payment of admission is-
 - (i) rupee one or less -- fifty per entum
 - such payment;
 - (ii) more than ru ees two-one hundred percentum of such payment:

Provided that the maximum ceiling of such tickets including the tax shall not exceed supees twenty in case of admission to commatograph exhibition."
