An Act

to provide for the authorisation of appropriation of moneys out of the Consolidated Fund of the State to meet the amounts spent on certain services during the financial year ended on the 31st day of March 1953, in excess of the amount authorised or granted for the said services.

BE it hereby enacted in the Seventh Year of the Republic of India as follows:-

1. This Act may be called the Assam Appro-

priation (No.VIII) Act, 1956.

2.
