No.LGL.26/84/27.—The following Act of the Assam Legislative Assembly which received the assent of the President is hereby published for general information.

(Assam Act XIV of 1985)

THE ASSAM STATE TRANSPORT CORPORATION (PREVENTION OF UNAUTHORISED TRAVEL) (AMENDMENT) ACT, 1985

An Act

to amend the Assam State Transport Corporation (Prevention of Unauthorised Travel) Act, 1977.

Preamble.

Whereas it is expedient further to amend the Assam State Transport Corporation (Prevention of Unauthorised Travel) Act, 1977, hereinafter referred to as the principal Act, in the manner hereinafter appearing:

It is hereby enacted in the Thirty-sixth Year of the Republic of India as follows:—

Short title, extent and commencement.

- 1. (1) This Act may be called the Assam State
 Transport Corporation (Prevention of
 Unauthorised Travel) (Amendment) Act,
 1985.
 - (2) It shall have the like extent as the principal Act.

(3) It shall come into force at once.
2. In the principal Act, Section 8 shall be substituted as follows:—

Amendment of Section 8 of the Principal Act (Act VI of 1977).

Power to remove persons from transport vehicles. "8. Any person who travels or attempts to travel in a transport vehicle without having valid ticket with him or travels beyond the place authorised by his ticket or who being inside the transport vehicle, fails or refuses to present his ticket for examination when required to do so, shall, on demand by an employee of the Corporation authorised in that behalf, be liable, in case of travel by city and suburban service, to pay a fine of ten rupees and in case of services other than city and suburban services, to double the amount of fare from the place of origin of the service to the terminus in addition to the actual fare payable and may also be removed

from such vehicle by an employee of the Corporation authorised in that behalf or by any other person whom such employee may call to his aid, unless he at once pays the fine, or the actual fare and double the amount of fare, as the case may be. The employee of the Corporation so authorised shall issue proper receipt to the defaulting passenger after collecting the fine or fare, as the case may be."
