to amend the Assam Betterment and Mooring Tax (Dibrugarh) Act, 1953.

Preamble.—Whereas it is expedient to amend the Assam Betterment Fee and Mooring Tax (Dibrugarh) Act, 1953 (Assam Act XIII of 1953) hereinafter called the Principal Act in the manner hereinafter appearing.

It is hereby enacted in the Fifth Year of the Republic of India as

1. Short title, extent and commencement.—(1) This Act may be called the Assam Betterment Fee and Mooring Tax (Dibrugarh) (Amend-

(2) It shall have like extent as the Principal Act.

(3) It shall come into force on the date on which the Principal Act comes into force.

2. Amendment of the Schedule to the Assam Act XIII of 1953.— In the Schedule to the Principal Act the words "realisable in annual instalments over the period as fixed under sub-section (1) of Section 5" appearing in the entries against 'Belt A', 'Belt B', 'Belt C' and 'Belt D'

ASSAM ACT XXXIV OF 1954

THE ASSAM CONTINGENCY FUND (AUGMENTATION OF . CORPUS) ACT, 1954

(Passed by the Assembly)

(Received the assent of the Governor of Assam on the 29th November 1954)

Preamble.—Whereas it is expedient to augment the Corpus of the Contingency Fund of the State of Assam.

It is hereby enacted in the Fifth Year of the Republic of India as follows :-

1. Short title, extent and commencement.—(1) This Act may be called the Assam Contingency Fund (Augmentation of Corpus) Act, 1954.

(2) It shall come into force at once.

2. Further payment to the Contingency Fund.—There shall be paid by the State Government into the Contingency Fund of the State of Assam a further sum of Rs.20 lakhs out of the Revenues of the State for the financial year 1954-55.
