THE ASSAM APPROPRIATION (No. II) ACT, 1985

Am

to authorise payment and appropriation of certain sums from and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Assam for the services of the financial year 1985-86.

Be it enacted by the Assam Legislative Assembly in the Thirty-sixth Year of the Republic of India as follows:-

Short title.

1. This Act may be called the Assam Appropriation (No. II) Act, 1985.

1985-86.

Withdrawal of Rs.1879,71,16,000 from and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Assam there may be paid and applied sums not the Consolidated exceeding those specified in column (3) of the Schedule Fund of the State amounting in the aggregate to the sum of one thousand of Assam for the eight hundred seventy-nine crores, seventy-one lakhs and year sixteen thousand rupees towards defraying the several charges which will come in course of payment during the financial year, 1985-86 in respect of the services specified in column (2) of the Schedule.

Appropriation.

3. The sums authorised to be withdrawn from and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Assam by this Act shall be appropriated for the services and purposes expressed in the Schedule in relation to the year ending on the Thirty-first day of March, 1986.
