> An Act.

to authorise payment and appropriation of certain further sums from and out of the Consolidated Fand of the State of Assam for the services of the financial year, 1984-85.

Be it enacted by the Assam Legislative Assembly in the Thirty-fifth Year of the Republic of India as follows:—

Short title.

1. This Act may be called the Assam Appropriation (No. IV) Act, 1984.

Withdrawal of Rs. 19,98,05,400 1984-85.

2. From and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Assam there may be paid and applied sums not exceeding those specified in column (3) of the Schedule the Consolidated exceeding those specified in column (3) of the Schedule Fund of the State amounting in the aggregate to the sum of nineteen of Assam for the Crores, ninety-eight lakhs, five thousand and four hundred financial year rupees towards defraving the several charges which rupees towards defraying the several charges which will come in course of payment during the financial year, 1984-85 in respect of the services specified in column (2) of the Schedule,

Appropriation.

3. The sums authorised to be withdrawn from and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Assam by this Act shall be appropriated for the services and purposes expressed in the Schedule in relation to the said year.
