Be it enacted by the Assam Legislative Assembly as follows:-

Short title.

1. This Act may be called the Assam Appropriation (No.III) Act, 1954.

ASSAM ACT XXIII OF 1954 THE ASSAM LOCAL SELF-GOVERNMENT (AMENDMENT) ACT, 1954

(Passed by the Assembly)

An Act to amend the Assam Local Self-Government Act, 1953

Preamble.—Whereas it is expedient to amend the Assam Local Self-Government Act, 1953 (Assam Act XXV of 1953), hereinafter referred to as the principal Act, in the manner hereinafter appearing;

It is hereby enacted in the fifth year of our Republic as follows:

1. Short title, extent and commencement.—(1) This Act may be called the Assam Local Self-Government (Amendment) Act, 1954.

(2) It shall come into force at once.

Amendment of section 1.—In section 1 of the principal Act—

 (a) In sub-section (2) the words "or the Assam Rural Panchayat Act, 1948" shall be deleted.
