THE ASSAM APPROPRIATION (NO.III) ACT, 2013

AN ACT

to authorise payment and appropriation of certain further sums from and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Assam for the services of the financial year, 2013-2014.

Be it enacted by the Assam Legislative Assembly in the Sixty-fourth Year of the Republic of India as follows:-

Short title

Withdrawal of Rs.2140,25,34,000 from and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Assam for the financial year, 2013-2014

- 1. This Act may be called the Assam Appropriation (No.III) Act, 2013.
- 2. From and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Assam there may be paid and applied sums not exceeding those specified in column (3) of the Schedule amounting in the aggregate to the sum of Two thousand One hundred Forty crore Twenty-Five lakh Thirty-Four thousand rupees towards defraying the several charges which will come in course of payment during the financial year 2013-2014 in respect of the services specified in column (2) of the Schedule.

Appropriation

3. The sums authorised to be withdrawn from and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Assam by this Act shall be appropriated for the services and purposes expressed in the Schedule in relation to the said year ending on the Thirty-first day of March, 2014.
