THE ASSAM APPROPRIATION (No. IV) ACT, 1973

[Published in the Assam Gazette Extraordinary, dated the 12th January 1974]

Act

to provide for the withdrawal of certain further sums from and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Assam to the service of the year ending on the thirty-first day of March, 1974.

Short title. It is hereby enacted in the Twenty-fourth year of the Republic of India as follows:—

1. This Act may be called the Assam Appropriation (No. IV) Act, 1973.

Withdrawal of Rs. 4,76,90,615 from and out of the consolidated Fund of the State of Assam for the financial year 1973-74

2. From and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Assam there may be paid and applied sums not exceeding those specified in column (3) of the Schedule amounting in the aggregate to the sum of Rupees four crores seventy-six lakhs ninety thousand six hundred and fifteen towards defraying the several charges which will come in course of payment during the year ending on the thirty-first day of March, 1974 in respect of the services specified in column (2) of the Schedule.

Appropriation.

3. The sums authorised to be paid and applied from and out of the consolidated Fund of the State of Assam by this Act, shall be appropriated for the services and purposes expressed in the Schedule in relation to the year ending on the thirty-first day of March, 1974.
