THE ASSAM APPROPRIATION (No.IV) ACT, 1971

(Received the assent of the Governor on the 29th November, 1971)

Act

to provide for the withdrawal of certain further sums from and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Assam to the service for the year ending on the thirty first day of March, 1972.

Short title. It is hereby enacted in the Twenty-second Year of the Republic of India as follows:—

1. This Act may be called the Assam Appropriation (No.IV) Act, 1971.

Withdrawal of Rs.20,00,16,798 from and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Assam for the financial year 1971-72.

2. From and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Assam there may be paid and applied sums not exceeding those specified in column (3) of the Schedule amounting in the aggregate to the sum of Rupees Twenty crores, sixteen thousand, seven hundred and ninety-eight towards defraying the several charges which will come in course of payment during the year ending on the thirty-first day of March, 1972, the in respect of the services specified in column (2) of the Schedule.

Appropriation. 3. The sums authorised to be paid and applied from and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Assam by this Act, shall be appropriated for the services and purposes expressed in the Schedule in relation to the year ending on the thirty-first day of March, 1972.
