ASSAM ACT V OF 1978

(Received the assent of the Governor on 25th June, 1978)

THE ASSAM APPROPRIATION (NO II) ACT, 1978

An

Act

to provide for the withdrawal of certain sums from and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Assam to the services of the year ending on the thirty-first day of March, 1979.

Be it enacted in the Twenty-ninth Year of the Republic of India as follows:—

Short title and commencement. 1. (1) This Act may be called the Assam Appropriation (No. II) Act, 1978.

(2) It shall come into force with effect from 1st April, 1978.

Withdrawal of Rs.409,49,19,200 out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Assam for the financial year 1978-79. 2. From and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Assam, there may be paid and applied sums not exceeding those specified in column (3) of the Schedule amounting in the aggregate [inclusive of the sum specified in column (3) to the Assam Appropriation (Vote-on-Account) Act, 1978] to the sum of Rupees four hundred nine crores, forty nine lakhs, nineteen thousand and two hundred only towards defraying the several charges which will come in course of payment during the year ending on the thirty-first day of March, 1979 in respect of the services specified in column (2) of the Schedule.

Appropriation. 3. The sums, authorised to be withdrawn from and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Assam by this Act, shall be appropriated for the services and purposes expressed in the Schedule in relation to the year ending on the thirty-first day of March, 1979.
