

## ASSAM ACT X OF 1971

THE ASSAM APPROPRIATION (VOTE-ON-ACCOUNT)  
ACT, 1971

(Received the assent of the Governor on the 26th March 1971)

[Published in the *Assam Gazette*, Extraordinary, dated the 27th March, 1971]**An****Act**

*to provide for the withdrawal of certain sums from and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Assam to the service of a Part of the financial year ending on the thirty-first day of March, 1972*

Be it hereby enacted in the Twenty-second Year of the Republic of India as follows:—

**Short title, and commencement.** 1. This Act may be called the Assam Appropriation (Vote on Account) Act, 1971. The Act shall come into force with effect from 1st April, 1971.

**Withdrawal of Rs. 66,46,14,400 out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Assam for the financial year 1971-72.** 2. From and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Assam, there may be withdrawn sums not exceeding those specified in column (3) of the Schedule amounting in the aggregate to the sum of rupees sixty-six crores, forty-six lakhs, fourteen thousand and four hundred towards defraying the several charges which will come in course of payment during the period of three months beginning on the first day of April, 1971 in respect of the services specified in column (2) of the Schedule.

**Appropriation.** 3. The sums authorised to be withdrawn from and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Assam by this Act, shall be appropriated for the services and purposes and expressed in the Schedule in relation to the year ending on the thirty-first day of March, 1972.
