

ASSAM ACT XIII OF 1978

(Received the assent of the Governor on 2nd December 1978)

THE ASSAM APPROPRIATION (NO. IV) ACT, 1978

An
Act

to provide for the authorisation of appropriation of moneys out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Assam to meet the amounts spent on certain services during the financial year ended on the 31st day of March, 1971 in excess of the amount authorised or granted for the said services.

It is hereby enacted in the Twenty-ninth Year of the Republic of India as follows:—

Short title. 1. This Act may be called the Assam Appropriation (No. IV) Act, 1978.

Issue of Rs. 19,68,69,454 from and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Assam for the financial year 1970-71.

2. From and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Assam, the sums specified in column (3) of the Schedule amounting in the aggregate to the sum of nineteen crores, sixty-eight lakhs, sixty-nine thousand four hundred and fifty-four shall be deemed to have been paid and applied to meet the amounts spent for defraying the charges in respect of the services specified in column (2) of the Schedule during the financial year ended on the 31st day of March, 1971 in excess of the amounts authorised or granted for those Services for that year.

Appropriation 3. The sums deemed to have been paid and applied from and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Assam under this Act shall be appropriated for the services and purposes expressed in the Schedule in relation to the financial year ended on the 31st day of March, 1971.
