No.LGL.422/78/3.—The following Act of the Assam Legislative Assembly which received the assent of the Governor is hereby published for general information.

Assam Act XVI of 1978

(Received the assent of the Governor on 20th December, 1978)

THE ASSAM APPROPRIATION (NO. VII) ACT, 1978
An
Act*to provide for the withdrawal of certain further sums from and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Assam to the Service of the year ending on the thirty-first day of March, 1979.*

It is hereby enacted in the Twenty-ninth Year of the Republic of India as follows:—

Short title.

1. This Act may be called the Assam Appropriation (No. VII) Act, 1978.

Withdrawal of Rs. 15,21,62,655 from and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Assam for the financial year 1978-79.

2. From and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Assam, there may be paid and applied sums not exceeding those specified in column (3) of the Schedule amounting in the aggregate to the sum of Rupees fifteen crores, twenty-one lakhs, sixty-two thousand, six hundred and fifty-five towards defraying the several charges which will come in course of payment during the year ending on the thirty-first day of March, 1979 in respect of the services specified in column (2) of the Schedule.

Appropriation.

3. The sums, authorised to be paid and applied from and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Assam by this Act, shall be appropriated for the services and purposes expressed in the Schedule in relation to the year ending on the thirty-first day of March, 1979.
