Amendment of section 7 of Act XVI of 1955. **2. In Section 7 of the principal Act, in sub-section (1), the full-stop at the end shall be substituted by a comma and the following words, thereafter, followed by a full-stop shall be added, namely:—**

“Subject to prior approval of Government in the Finance Department.”

**further to amend the Assam Land and Revenue Regulation, 1886**

Preamble.

Whereas it is expedient further to amend the Assam Land and Revenue Regulation, 1886 hereinafter referred to as the said Regulation, in the manner herein after appearing;

It is hereby enacted in the Twenty-second Year of the Republic of India, as follows:—

Short title, extent and commencement. 1.(1) This Act may be called the Assam Land and Revenue Regulation (first Amendment) Act, 1971.

(2) It shall have the like extent as the said Regulation.

(3) It shall come into force at once.

Amendment of Section 91 of Regulation I of 1886. 2. For Sub-section (1) of section 91, of the said Regulation the following shall be substituted, namely:—

“Power to proceed against defaulter's other immovable property,

91.(1) If an arrear of an estate in which the settlement-holder has not a permanent, heritable and transferable right of use and occupancy, cannot be recovered by the Process mentioned in Section 69, and an arrear in respect of any other estate, cannot be recovered by any of the processes mentioned in this chapter;

And the defaulter is in possession of any immovable property other than the estate in respect of which the arrear has accrued, the Deputy Commissioner may proceed against any of that other property situated within his district according to law for the time being in force for the attachment and sale of immovable property under the decree of a civil court."

further to amend the Assam Land and Revenue Regulation, 1886

**Preamble.** Whereas it is expedient further to amend the Assam Land and Revenue Regulation, 1886, hereinafter called the Regulation, in the manner hereinafter appearing. Assam Regulation I of 1886.

It is hereby enacted in the Twenty-second Year of the Republic of India as follows:—

**Short title, extent and commencement.** 1.(1) This Act may be called the Assam Land and Revenue Regulation, (Second Amendment) Act 1971.

(2) It shall have the like extent as the Regulation.

(3) It shall come into force at once.

**Amendment of section 154 of Assam Regulation I of 1886.** 2. In Section 154 of the Regulation, in sub-section (1) after clause (m), the following shall be inserted as clause (n) and shall always be deemed to have been inserted, namely:—

"(n) any matter regarding ejection of any person from a land over which no person has accrued the right of a proprietor, land-holder or settlement-holder and the disposal of any crop raised, or any building or other construction erected without authority on such land."
