THE ASSAM APPROPRIATION (No.II) ACT, 1970

**An
Act**

to provide for the withdrawal of certain sums from and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Assam to the service of the year ending on the thirty-first day of March 1971

It is hereby enacted in the Twenty-first Year of the Republic of India as follows:—

Short title and commencement. (1) This Act may be called the Assam Appropriation (No.II) Act, 1970.

(2) This Act shall come into force with effect from 1st April, 1970.

Withdrawal of Rs. 2,71,37,73,100 from and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Assam for the financial year 1970-71. 2. From and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Assam, there may be paid and applied sums not exceeding those specified in column (3) of the Schedule amounting in the aggregate [inclusive of the sum specified in column 3 of the schedule to the Assam Appropriation (Vote on Account Act, 1970) to the sum of two hundred and seventy-one crores, thirty-seven lakhs, seventy-three thousand, and one hundred rupees towards defraying the several charges which will come in course of payment during the year ending on the thirty-first day of March, 1971 in respect of the services specified in column (2) of the Schedule.

Appropriation. 3. The sums authorised to be paid and applied from and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Assam by this Act, shall be appropriated for the services and purposes expressed in the Schedule in relation to the year ending on the thirty-first day of March, 1971.
