THE ASSAM BETTERMENT FEE AND MOORING TAX
(DIBRUGARH) (AMENDMENT) ACT, 1965

further to amend the Assam Betterment Fee and Mooring Tax
(Dibrugarh) Act, 1953.

Preamble Whereas it is expedient further to amend the Assam Betterment Fee and Mooring Tax (Dibrugarh) Act, 1953, hereinafter called the principal Act, in the manner hereinafter appearing ;
It is hereby enacted in the Sixteenth Year of the Republic of India as follows :—

Short title, extent and commencement. 1. (1) This Act may be called the Assam Betterment Fee and Mooring Tax (Dibrugarh) (Amendment) Act, 1965.

(2) It shall have the like extent as the principal Act.

(3) It shall come into force at once.

Amendment of Section 5 of Assam Act XIII of 1953. 2. In sub-section (3) of section 5 of the principal Act, for the words "to the State Government in the prescribed manner" the words "to the Assam Board of Revenue" shall be substituted.

Transfer of appeal cases pending with the State Government. 3. All appeals pending with the State Government immediately before the date of the coming into force of this Act, shall stand transferred to the Assam Board of Revenue and shall be heard and disposed of by the Assam Board of Revenue as if they had been originally filed before that Board.
