ASSAM ACT XXI OF 1964

THE ASSAM APPROPRIATION (No. III) ACT, 1964

[Published in the Assam Gazette Extraordinary, dated the 27th October 1964]

An Act

to provide for the withdrawal of certain further sums from and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Assam to the service of the year ending on the thirty-first day of March, 1965.

It is hereby enacted in the Fifteenth Year of the Republic of India as follows:--

Short title. 1. This Act may be called the Assam Appropriation (No.III) Act, 1964.

Withdrawal of Rs.5,33,48,895 from and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Assam for the financial year 1964-65. 2. From and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Assam there may be paid and applied sums not exceeding those specified in column (3) of the Schedule amounting in the aggregate to the sum of five crores, thirty-three lakhs, forty-eight thousand, eight hundred and ninety-five rupees towards defraying the several charges which will come in course of payment during the year ending on the thirty-first day of March, 1965 in respect of the services specified in column (2) of the Schedule.

Appropriation. 3. The sums authorised to be paid and applied from and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Assam by this Act shall be appropriated for the services and purposes expressed in the Schedule in relation to the year ending on the thirty-first day of March, 1965.
