An Act

to provide for the withdrawal of certain further sums from and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Assam to the service of the year ending on the thirty-first day of March, 1965.

It is hereby enacted in the Fisteenth Year of the Republic of India as follows:—

Short title. 1. This Act may be called the Assam Appropriation (No.III) Act, 1964.

Withdrawal 2. From and out of the Consolidated Fund of the of State of Assam there may be paid and applied sums from and out not exceeding those specified in column (3) of the of the Con-Schedule amounting in the aggregate to the sum of solidated five crores, thirty-three lakhs, forty-eight thousand, Fund of the seight hundred and ninety-five rupees towards defraying Assam for the several charges which will come in course of paythe financial ment during the year ending on the thirty-first day year 1964- of March, 1965 in respect of the services specific 165. in column (2) of the Schedule.

Appropriation.

3. The sums authorised to be paid and applied from and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Assam by this Act shall be appropriated for the services and purposes expressed in the Schedule in relation to the year ending on the thirty-first day of March, 1965.
