Will the Minister of General Administration Department be pleased to state:

- (a) Whether the Govt. or concerned Department is aware or not about the inclusion of 81 Nos. of villages from Sonitpur, Biswanath, Darrang and Nalbari District in Bodoland Territorial Council? If yes, then submit details.
- (b) Whether the Govt. is aware or not about the allocation of funds to those villages? If yes, then state the allocated funds during the last financial year and its implementing authority of schemes in those villages?
- (c) If the schemes are not implemented in those villages, may the concerned Department submit the details/reasons for not implementing the Schemes?
- (d) Will the Govt./concerned Department allocate the budget in this financial year 2026-27?

ANSWER

Hon'ble Minister of Welfare of Bodoland Department, Shri Charan Boro would reply:

- (a) The Government of Assam is aware about the inclusion of 81 Nos. of villages from Sonitpur, Biswanath, Darrang and Nalbari District under Bodoland Territorial Region. Copy of the Notifications enclosed at Annexure- A, B & C.
