তিতাবৰ সমষ্টিৰ অন্তৰ্গত বহু বিদ্যালয় একত্ৰীকৰণৰ ফলত বন্ধ হৈ গ'ল আৰু বিদ্যালয়সমূহ পৰিত্যক্ত অৱস্থাত আছে। উক্ত বিদ্যালয়সমূহত বহু সমাজ বিৰোধী কাম চলি থকা বুলি অৱগত হৈছে, গতিকে এই বন্ধ হৈ থকা বিদ্যালয়সমূহত ভবিষ্যতে অন্যান্য ৰাজহুৱা আঁচনি ৰূপায়ণৰ ক্ষেত্ৰত কিবা সু-পৰিকল্পনা আছে নেকি?

তথ্য অনুসৰি তিতাবৰ সমষ্টিৰ অন্তৰ্গত কোনো বিদ্যালয় বন্ধ হোৱা নাই। একত্ৰীকৰণৰ বাবে কিছু সংখ্যক বিদ্যালয় স্থানান্তৰিত হৈছে, যাৰ ফলত, সেই বিদ্যালয়গৃহ সমূহ অব্যৱহৃত হৈ আছে। অব্যৱহৃত হৈ পৰা গৃহ আৰু সংশ্লিষ্ট ভূমি/জমিৰ যাতে সঠিক ব্যৱহাৰ হয়, তাৰ বিষয়ে বিদ্যালয় শিক্ষা বিভাগে সুপৰিকল্পিত ব্যৱস্থা গ্ৰহণ কৰিবলৈ জিলা আয়ুক্ত সকলক কৰ্তৃত্ব প্ৰদান কৰি ইতিমধ্যে ইংৰাজী ০২-০৪-২০২৫ তাৰিখে কাৰ্যালয় স্মাৰক নং ই-৬৩৪৯৩১/৭ যোগে নিৰ্দেশনা জাৰি কৰিছে।

উক্ত কাৰ্যালয় স্মাৰক অনুসৰি, জিলা আয়ুক্তসকলে ৰাজহ আৰু দুৰ্যোগ ব্যৱস্থাপনা বিভাগৰ অনুমোদন সাপেক্ষে উক্ত ভূমি যিকোনো চৰকাৰী বিভাগ বা সংস্থা আৱণ্টন কৰিব পাৰিব। লগতে, চৰকাৰী বিভাগ/সংস্থাৰ বাহিৰেও প্ৰয়োজন অনুসৰি জিলা আয়ুক্তই বেচৰকাৰী সংস্থা (NGO) আদিকো চৰকাৰৰ অনুমোদন সাপেক্ষে উক্ত ভূমি আৱণ্টন কৰিব পাৰিব। ইতিমধ্যে ৰাজ্যৰ জিলা সমূহত জিলা আয়ুক্তৰ দ্বাৰা এই সংক্ৰান্তত সঠিক পদক্ষেপ লোৱা দেখা গৈছে। সংশ্লিষ্ট কাৰ্যালয় স্মাৰক ইয়াৰ লগত সংলগ্ন কৰা হৈছে।

Subject:Guidelines for utilization of vacant,unattended and unused land and infrastructure arising due to amalgamation/merger of Schools/provincialisation and shifting to Base school

To prevent potential misuse and deterioration of the land and existing infrastructure which remained unattended and unused due to amalgamation/merger of Schools, and in compliance to the Cabinet decision taken in the meeting dated 20/03/2025, the following guidelines are hereby issued -

1. After closure of school due to amalgamation, provincialisation and shifting to a base school; the land will be deemed to be given "Istafa" by the SMC/SMDC or the Education department
2. The DC will be free to allot the land to any Govt. department or agency. However, DC will have to take approval of the Revenue and & DM department to allot the land to anyone, including NGO, other than Govt. department/agency
3. The District Level Committee (unused property of amalgamated/ merged School) shall be constituted which shall consist of the following members:-

The District Commissioner	-----	Chairman
The Co District Commissioner	-----	Vice Chairman
The Inspector of Schools	-----	Member Secretary
The District Elementary Education Officer	-----	Member
The Circle Officer of the concerned Revenue Circle	-----	Member
The Block Development Officer(respective jurisdiction)	-----	Member
The Block Elementary Education Officer (respective jurisdiction)		Member
One Retired Principal/ Headmaster of Govt./ProvincialisedSchool		Member
One working Principal/Headmaster of Govt./ProvincialisedSchool		Member

- Before placing such matter before the District Level Committee (unused property of amalgamated/mergedSchool),the Member Secretary and the DEEO shall jointly examine the matter as per the Guidelines and arrange all documents that are required to be placed. Further,the Member Secretary and DEEO needs to ensure that there is no ongoing court litigation in connection with the amalgamation order already issued and complied, and also in connection with the land property.
- The District Commissioner of the concerned District shall issue "permission to use" to the concerned authority for utilization of the unattended/ unused School campuses/ properties by signing anMoU between the District Commissioner (1st Party) and the Party (Government/ Semi Government/ NGO) (2nd Party) after obtaining recommendation from the District Level Committee (unused property of amalgamated/ merged School

- ❑ In this connection, 526 Lower Primary Schools has been upgraded to Upper Primary Schools under DEE, Assam.
