- (a) Is the Government aware of serious erosion of river Beki in the following villages:

Shawrachara Gaon (R/B), Shawrachara Pather (L/B & R/B), Mazidbhita (R/B), Daukmari (R/B), Sonpura (L/B & R/B), Kharballi (L/B & R/B), Kalampur (L/B & R/B), Rasulpur (L/B & R/B), Kaurjahi (R/B), Galia (R/B), Srirampur (R/B), Banglipara (R/B), Kasukati (R/B), Baniarapara (R/B), Satrakanara 14 No. Seat (L/B), Morabhaj (L/B), Sheorarbhita (L/B), Sonapur (R/B & L/B), 1 No. Rasulpur (R/B & L/B), Chandpur (R/B), Alipur (R/B & L/B), Koemari (L/B & R/B), Tapajuli Pather (L/B & R/B), Hassanpur (R/B & L/B)?
- b) If yes, would the Government be pleased to take immediate measures for protection?
- c) Is it true that, proposals under "No Regret" for protection of Balaipather, Kharballi and Amguri were submitted under WB?
- d) If yes, what is the present status?
- e) What is the present status of implementation of proposals under "Variation" for villages Amguri and Bardanga under WB?

-ANSWER-

- a) Yes, the Department is aware of the ongoing erosion at the under mentioned locations and the officials from the department have already visited the erosion prone areas viz-

Shawrachara Gaon (R/B), Shawrachara Pather (L/B & R/B), Mazidbhita (R/B), Daukmari (R/B), Sonpura (L/B & R/B), Kharballi (L/B & R/B), Kalampur (L/B & R/B), Rasulpur (L/B & R/B), Kaurjahi (R/B), Galia (R/B), Srirampur (R/B), Banglipara (R/B), Kasukati (R/B), Baniarapara (R/B), Satrakanara 14 No. Seat (L/B), Morabhaj (L/B), Sheorarbhita (L/B), Sonapur (R/B & L/B), 1 No. Rasulpur (R/B & L/B), Chandpur (R/B), Alipur (R/B & L/B), Koemari (L/B & R/B), Tapajuli Pather (L/B & R/B), Hassanpur (R/B & L/B).

- b) At present the department is taking up immediate measures at vulnerable reaches Sharwachara area, Morabhaj and Sheorabhita area under Flood Drill head by launching of PSC porcupine supplied from the Central Go-down of Water Resource Department and the protective measures are going on. At Kaurjahi area the Department has launched sand filled Mega Bags as protective measures as and when required.

The department has submitted the following schemes for taking up erosion protection measures including other mentioned areas, as enclosed at **Annexure-I**. The Govt. is under active consideration for according necessary approval subject to availability of fund.

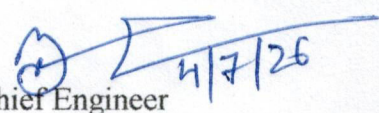
Again, under AIRBMP "Construction and Upgrading of river works along the Beki River for reducing flood and river erosion risk (Emergency protection work at Chunbari, Maithabari, Nepalibasti, Biharibasti, Barobasti & U/S of Gobardhan Satra, Katajhar and Kaurjahi" funded by World Bank, the protection of Kaurjahi area was taken up under a comprehensive scheme as high priority works which also covers areas like Chunbari, Maithabari, Nepalibasti, Biharibasti, Barobasti, U/S of Gobardhana Satra and Katajhar. The total bank protection work taken up under the scheme was 4.140 Km amounting to Rs.32.99 Cr.

- c) The no-regret works considered at 26 locations of Beki River has already been completed. However, locations namely Balaipathar, Kharballi and Amguri were not included in the Phase-I part of the project.
- d) The work in the three locations can be taken up only after clearance of WB Ph-II and inclusion in the Integrated Flood Management Plan (IFREMP) which is under preparation.
- e) The works under the "Variation" estimate for villages Amguri and Bardanga under WB have not yet been executed due to ongoing land acquisition issues and will be executed after the land issue is resolved.
