The proposal for enhancement of salaries and other allowances of Hon'ble Chief, Speaker, Deputy Chief, Deputy Speaker, Executive Members, Leader of Opposition & Members, BTCLA submitted by the Committee on Salaries, Allowances, Pension and Other Facilities of Members, BTCLA was discussed in EC.

EC discussed the matter and decided to curtail the salary of the Hon'ble Chief, BTC, Hon'ble Deputy Chief, BTC, Hon'ble Executive Members and Hon'ble MCLAs @30% for 6 (six) months w.e.f. April, 2026 owing to current global crisis. The recommendation of the Committee will be reviewed after 6 months.

EXECUTIVE ORDER

Sub: Advisory on Austerity Measures to ensure Fiscal Prudence.

In the interest of administrative propriety and in view of the national appeal arising from the prevailing crisis in West Asia, the Government considers it necessary to enforce additional measures of fiscal prudence and economy.

The Finance Department has, from time to time, issued general instructions on austerity measures with a view to containing non-developmental expenditure and mobilizing additional resources for priority schemes. Such measures are intended to promote fiscal discipline without adversely affecting the operational efficiency of the Government.

In the present circumstances, which require heightened administrative readiness and national solidarity, the following directions are hereby issued to all Administrative Departments and District Administrations for strict compliance until further orders:

A. Reduction of Establishment Expenditure:

- Ban on purchase of new vehicles for the next 6 (six) months.
- Official vehicle movement within the State to be minimized.
- Official or private foreign visits by Ministers and Government officials shall remain deferred for the next six (6) months, except where such visits are necessitated by national or strategic interests, educational or medical purposes, or visits to immediate family members residing abroad, subject to prior

approval of the Hon'ble Chief Minister, Assam.

- The convoy of the Hon'ble Chief Minister, Hon'ble Ministers and Senior Officials shall be reduced without compromising the prescribed security protocol.
- Non-essential official travel within the State or outside the State shall be restricted.
- Inter-district movement of CAPF/ Assam Police shall be restricted. In cases of urgency relating to law and order, prior approval of the Government shall be obtained. Home & Political Department will issue necessary directives in this regard.
- All old and obsolete Government vehicles shall be scrapped immediately. General Administration Department shall issue specific guidelines in this regard.
- Priority shall be given to Electric Vehicles at the time of hiring of vehicles by the Departments.
- 20% reduction in POL (Petrol, Oil, and Lubricants) expenditure shall be implemented during the current financial year.
- Large gatherings or physical meetings may be deferred or shifted to virtual mode unless related to essential services.
- Working lunches, official dinners, cultural functions, lavish hospitality arrangements and entertainment expenses, at the cost of public exchequer, shall be avoided.
- Non-essential training programmes or exposure visits involving travel may be avoided. International travels, both official and personal, may be deferred and the same will be reviewed after 6 (six) months. Officers who have received prior approval but have not yet undertaken such journey are encouraged to reconsider their plans.
- Permanent existing buildings, seminar halls, auditoriums should be used for organizing unavoidable Government functions instead of constructing temporary pandals.
- 10% cut in revenue/ establishment expenditure in current year vis-à-vis FY 2025-26. Exemptions include salaries, pensions, debt repayment and charged expenditure.

B. Enhancing Revenue Generation:

- Departments shall ensure timely revision and rationalization of

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user charges, licence fees, lease rents and service charges wherever feasible.

- All Administrative Departments shall take necessary steps to utilize the assets i.e. buildings, community halls etc. constructed under various schemes by developing a mechanism to utilize them commercially and generate revenues for the State.
- Revenue generating activities should invariably be through the Electronic Government Receipt Accounting System, (e-GRAS) module i.e. online only.

C. Energy Audit and Energy Management:

- Departments should carry out energy audit in offices under it to reduce wastage of electricity.
- Municipal authorities to undertake economy in power consumption by avoiding wasteful usage of streetlights etc.

D. Further, the following measures to ensure austerity may also be adhered to:

- Economy in consumption of Petrol and Diesel for personal works.
- Promotion of Public transport, Carpooling and EV usage.
- Transport Department to issue notification regarding incentives to buy EVs by public at large and to develop public EV charging infrastructure across the State.
- DoHUA to initiate transition of municipal public transport towards non-fossil fuel alternatives over the next 12 months; Guwahati Municipal Corporation to transition towards a fully green public transport system.

The undersigned is directed to further inform all the Senior Most Secretaries to ensure compliance of the above austerity measures in the greater interest of the State and the Country.
