**Will the Minister of Water Resources Department be pleased to state:
-Questions-**

- a) Is the Govt. aware that under Sidli-Chirang (ST) LAC the Aai and Nangal Rivers have been affected drastically by erosion in more than 40% Northern areas i.e. Amteka, Roumari, Khunkrajhora, Nangal Bhanga, Nijla etc. and downstream areas i.e. Nepal Bazar, Rowmary, Dowkanagar and many people have become homeless?
- b) If yes, then will the Government do the needful and survey the erosion affected areas as early as possible and allot sufficient fund to protect the erosion areas in this financial year 2026-2027?

**Hon'ble Minister of Water Resources Department, Sri Sushanta Borgohain

–ANSWER–

- a) The Water Resources Department is aware of various areas under the Sidli-Chirang (ST) LAC, which are vulnerable and affected by erosion due to the Aie river and Nangal river, including areas like Amteka, Roumari, Khunkrajhora, Nangal Bhanga, Nijla, Nepal Bazar, Rowmary, Dowkanagar, etc. thus affecting many people.
- b) The Water Resources Department is taking up necessary palliative measures of temporary nature in the erosion affected reaches. Further, the Department shall conduct necessary survey works in the vulnerable and erosion affected areas, once the monsoon is over and flood water recedes. Accordingly, the Department shall prepare and take up necessary measures in order to curb the progressive erosion in the vulnerable locations, subject to availability of funds.
