::Questions::

Will the Minister of Tourism Department be pleased to state:

(a) Whether the Government has any plan to develop Khaspur as a tourism spot? If so what are the steps taken so far for preservation and promotion of its historical and cultural heritage?

(b) Is there any amount of funds sanctioned and utilized for this purpose during the last three years and the proposed timeline or completion of tourism-related infrastructure and facilities in the area?

::Answers::

Hon'ble Minister of Tourism, Smti Ajanta Neog will give the reply:

(a) "Khaspur"- ruins of Cachari kingdom is a monument/site presently under the Archaeological Survey of India (ASI). 'Khaspur' features as a prominent tourist attraction in Assam Tourism Map. Moreover, the process of entering into a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) between Assam Tourism and the Archaeological Survey of India (ASI) is in advance stage which will pave the way for creating better tourism infrastructure in all ASI protected monuments.

(b) No fund was sanctioned and utilized for this purpose under Tourism Department, Government of Assam during the last three years.
