Ans :- (a) Soil & Water Conservation schemes executed by Soil Conservation Department in Sribhumi district during 2020-2021 is enclosed at **Annexure-A.**

Ans :- (b) In Soil Conservation Department, the Divisional Soil Conservation Officer is the head of the Division and he looks after all the developmental activities in the Division.

Barak Valley falls under the jurisdiction of Cachar Soil Conservation Division headed by Divisional Soil Conservation Officer, who is the higher authority in the Division. It may be mentioned that the districts of Cachar, Hailakandi and Sribhumi in Barak Valley falls under Cachar Soil Conservation Division.

For the record, it may be mentioned that there are no District wise Offices in Soil Conservation Department. There are 28 Divisional Offices each headed by one Divisional Soil Conservation Officer assisted by his team of officers in different cadres. The districts are subsumed within the Divisions.
