OFFICE MEMORANDUM

Sub : Terms & conditions for appointment of retired Civil Servant as Member, Foreigners Tribunal, Assam.

In pursuance of the approval accorded by the Ministry of Home Affairs, Government of India vide their letter No.11012/48/2005-NE.IV dated 13-05-2019 retired Civil Servants will now be considered for appointment as Members in the Foreigners Tribunals. The terms and conditions for such appointment have been laid down as follows:

1. An officer will have to be a retired civil servant (not below the rank of Secretary and Additional Secretary) having judicial experience.
2. Maximum age up to which the officer will be allowed to work as Member is 67 years.
3. The initial period of appointment shall be for one year which may be extended from time to time on need basis, subject to their attainment of maximum age fixed at 67 years.

Pay and allowance of the Members will be regulated as noted below:

Last pay drawn or Minimum pay in the revised scale corresponding to the post held at the time of superannuation, whichever is higher, minus pension plus Dearness Allowance at the rate admissible to the State Government employees.

In addition, special pay @ 15% of his pay subject to a maximum of Rs. 2000/- plus a special duty allowance @ 12.5% of the basic pay.

4. Conveyance:

A car along with staff car driver will be provided to each Member of Foreigners Tribunal who will be entitled to 60 (sixty) litres of P.O.L. per month.

5. Transfer grants:

Members of Foreigners Tribunals are entitled to transfer grants as admissible to Civil Service Officers of relevant/equivalent rank.

6. One Orderly peon will be admissible to each Member, Foreigners Tribunal with a fixed remuneration of Rs. 9000/- per month except in respect of those Foreigners Tribunals where Orderly Peon with Grade Pay has already been appointed. The tenure of engagement of the Orderly peon shall be co-terminus with the tenure of the Members.

7. House Rent allowance:

Rs. 4000/- P.M. (fixed).

8. Travelling Allowance/Transfer T.A.

As per State Government Rules as admissible to Civil Service Officers including transportation of personal effects as admissible to State Government officers.

9. For all other purposes, the retired Civil Servants serving as Member, Foreigners Tribunal shall be governed by the respective rules, notification, order, etc as admissible to Civil Service Officers of equivalent rank. Further, the retired Civil Servants serving as Member, Foreigners Tribunal shall be governed by the terms and conditions as spelt out above.

- Sub : Terms & conditions for appointment of Advocate as Member, Foreigners Tribunal, Assam.

(ii) This Department's Addendum Nos. PLB.154/2015/20 dated 26/11/2015 & PLB.160/2013/Pt-I/183 dated 04/02/2016

In partial modification of this Department's earlier Office Memorandum No. PLB.163/2010/229 dated 29/07/2015 and subsequent Addendum Nos. PLB.154/2015/20 dated 26/11/2015 and PLB.160/2013/Pt-I/183 dated 04/02/2016, and also in continuation of this Department's subsequent Office Memorandum No. PLB.163/2010/313 dated 10/01/2019, and with the approval of the Ministry of Home Affairs, Government of India vide letter No.11012/48/2005-NE.IV dated 13-05-2019, the terms and conditions for appointment of Advocates as Members in the Foreigners Tribunals have been laid down as follows :-

1. An Advocate not below the age of 35 (thirty five) years with at least 07 (seven) years of practice will be considered for appointment as Member in the Foreigners Tribunal of Assam.
2. Maximum age up to which Advocates will be allowed to work as Member is 67 years.
3. Appointment of Advocates as Member, Foreigners Tribunal will be purely on contractual basis with fixed pay of Rs.85,000/- (Rupees Eighty Five Thousand) only per month.
4. The initial period of appointment shall be for one year which may be extended from time to time on need basis, subject to their attainment of maximum age fixed at 67 years.
5. The Member shall be eligible for 12 (twelve) days special leave in a year as per State Government Rule. They will also avail earned leave as admissible as per Leave Rule 1934 (as amended).
6. A car alongwith Driver or monthly fixed conveyance allowance @ 5000/- per month will be provided to each Member who will be entitled to 60 (sixty) litres of P.O.L. per month.
7. **House Rent Allowance:**
Rs. 4000/- P.M. (fixed).
8. The selection of the Advocate as Member, Foreigners Tribunal will be done by a 3 (three) Member-Special Bench of the Gauhati High Court which is constituted by the Chief Justice of Gauhati High Court as per direction of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in W.P.(C) No. 562/2012 and the process of selection of Member, Foreigners Tribunal will

be done if required in phases, depending on the availability of officers opting to serve in the Tribunals.

9. For all other purposes, the Advocate serving as Member, Foreigners Tribunal in Assam shall be governed by the terms and conditions as spelt out above on condition that no other facilities are borne from the State Exchequer which are non-reimbursable from the Government of India.

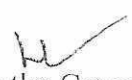

Sub : Terms & conditions for appointment of retired Judicial Officer as Member, Foreigners Tribunal, Assam.

Ref : This Department's earlier Office Memorandum No.PLB.163/2010/181 dated 25/05/2011

In partial modification of this Department's earlier Office Memorandum No. PLB.163/2010/181 dated 25/05/2011 and with the approval of the Ministry of Home Affairs, Government of India vide letter No.11012/48/2005-NE.IV dated 13-05-2019, the terms and conditions for appointment of retired Judicial Officers as Members in the Foreigners Tribunals have been laid down as follows :-

1. An officer will have to be a retired Judicial Officer from the Assam Judicial Service.
2. Maximum age up to which the officer will be allowed to work as Member is 67 years.
3. The initial period of appointment shall be for one year which may be extended from time to time on need basis, subject to their attainment of maximum age fixed at 67 years.

Pay and allowance of the Members will be regulated as noted below:

Last pay drawn or Minimum pay in the revised scale corresponding to the post held at the time of superannuation, whichever is higher, minus pension plus Dearness Allowance at the rate admissible to the State Government employees.

In addition, special pay @ 15% of his pay subject to a maximum of Rs. 2000/- plus a special duty allowance @ 12.5% of the basic pay.

4. Medical Facilities:

Medical facilities will be provided to Member, Foreigners Tribunal as per Judicial Department's Notification No. JDJ(E)-44/2002/Pt/34 Dated 7th March, 2007 read with Assam Medical Attendance Rules, 2008 and Notification issued thereunder from time to time.

5. Conveyance:

A car along with staff car driver will be provided to each Member of Foreigners Tribunal who will be entitled to 60 (sixty) litres of P.O.L. per month.

6. Transfer grants:

Members of Foreigners Tribunals are entitled to transfer grants as admissible to Judicial Officers of relevant rank.

7. One Orderly peon will be admissible to each Member, Foreigners Tribunal with a fixed remuneration of Rs. 9000/- per month except in respect of those Foreigners Tribunals where Orderly Peon with Grade Pay has already been appointed. The tenure of engagement of the Orderly peon shall be co-terminus with the tenure of the Members.
8. **House Rent allowance:**
Rs. 4000/- P.M. (fixed).
9. **Travelling Allowance/Transfer T.A.**
As per State Government Rules as admissible to Judicial Officers including transportation of personal effects as admissible to State Government officers.
10. A Member may avail of Home LTC once in a block period of two years. A Member may avail LTC once in four years as admissible to Member of the corresponding ranks in Assam Judicial Service and this facility will be restricted to his/her spouse and dependent children.
11. For all other purposes, the retired Judicial Officers serving as Member, Foreigners Tribunal shall be governed by the respective rules, notification, order, etc as admissible to Judicial Officers. Further, the retired Judicial Officers serving as Member, Foreigners Tribunal shall be governed by the terms and conditions as spelt out above.

Subject: - Immigration and Foreigners Act, 2025 (13 of 2025) and Rules / Orders framed thereunder - reg.

Sir/ Madam

I am directed to say that the Immigration and Foreigners Act, 2025 (13 of 2025) passed by the Parliament and notified on 4th April 2025 has come into force w.e.f. 1st September, 2025 in terms of the Notification S.O. No. 3981(E) dated 31st August, 2025 issued by this Ministry. A copy each of the Immigration and Foreigners Act, 2025 (13 of 2025) notified on 04.04.2025 and notification S.O. No. 3981 (E) dated 31.08.2025 referred to above is enclosed for information and necessary action. With the coming into force of the Immigration and Foreigners Act, 2025 (13 of 2025), four existing legislations dealing with foreigners i.e. the Passport (Entry into India) Act, 1920, the Registration of Foreigners Act, 1939, the Foreigners Act, 1946 and the Immigration (Carriers' Liability) Act, 2000 stands repealed as on 01.09.2025.

2. This Ministry has also framed the Immigration and Foreigners Rules, 2025, the Immigration and Foreigners Order, 2025 and various other notifications for implementation of the provisions of the Act and these have also been notified on 01.09.2025 / 02.09.2025. These have also come into force w.e.f. 01.09.2025/ 02.09.2025. Following Orders, Rules and other Notifications notified under the Immigration and Foreigners Act, 2025 may be downloaded from the online portal

It has been decided with the approval of the competent authority, that pending updation of the Visa Manual, 2019 so as to incorporate the provisions as in the Immigration and Foreigners Act, 2025 (13 of 2025) and rules & orders framed thereunder, all authorities concerned shall strictly follow the existing provisions in the Visa Manual, 2019 as amended from time to time for dealing with all Visa and Immigration related matters as far as they are consistent with the new provisions as in the Immigration and Foreigners Act, 2025 (13 of 2025) and the rules & orders framed thereunder. Various authorities as specified in Chapter 24 - Protected and Restricted Areas of the Visa Manual, 2019 shall continue to receive and grant Protected Area Permit (PAP) and Restricted Area Permit (RAP) as per the conditions prescribed therein for visit and stay of foreigners to protected and restricted areas as specified in Third and Fourth Schedule appended to the Immigration and Foreigners Order, 2025 until further orders.

4. It is requested that these instructions may please be brought to the notice of all concerned for strict compliance.
