Question

Will the Minister of Education Department be pleased to state:

- (a) Whether the Government has any proposal to upgrade certain M.E. Schools to High Schools and High Schools to Higher Secondary Schools in Udharbond Legislative Assembly Constituency, considering the inadequate number of schools in the constituency ?
- (b) Whether the Government has any proposal under consideration to establish a Model Degree College in Udharbond Legislative Assembly Constituency to enhance access to quality higher education for the students of the area ?
- (c) Whether the Government has any proposal to introduce Science and Commerce streams in Jagannath Singh College and to expand Science and Commerce education facilities for the students of Udharbond Legislative Assembly Constituency ?

Answer

Hon'ble Minister, Higher Education Department, Dr. Ranoj Pegu will reply :

- a) The Government is committed to strengthening and expanding access to quality school education across the State in a phased and need-based manner. In this regard, the School Education Department has notified the policy framework for upgradation of educational institutions through Office Memorandum No. E-555676 dated 03.11.2025 (**Annexure-A**) for upgradation of M.E./M.V. Schools to High Schools and Office Memorandum No. E-244416/8 dated 11.01.2023 (**Annexure-B**) for upgradation of High Schools to Higher Secondary Schools.

The proposals for upgradation of schools are considered strictly in accordance with the eligibility criteria, norms and conditions prescribed in the aforesaid Office Memoranda, including, inter alia, enrolment strength, availability of land, school infrastructure, classroom accommodation, laboratory facilities, teaching staff, accessibility, educational need of the locality and other relevant parameters.

Accordingly, if any M.E./M.V. School or High School situated within the Udharbond Legislative Assembly Constituency fulfils the prescribed norms and is found eligible on due verification by the competent authority, the Government shall take necessary action for its upgradation to the next higher level, subject to administrative approval, availability of budgetary provision and compliance with all applicable Government policies and procedures.

- b) Considering the proposal forwarded by the Directorate of Higher Education vide Office Letter No. PC/HE/Misc.26/2023/61 dated 19.09.2025 (**Annexure-C**), the Government of Assam, Higher Education Department, after due examination of the matter, has accorded approval for establishment of a Model Degree College in Udharbond Legislative Assembly Constituency.

Accordingly, vide Government Letter bearing eFile No. 605514/11 dated 24.11.2025 (**Annexure-D**), the Directorate of Higher Education has been directed to initiate all necessary administrative and statutory formalities for establishment of the said Model Degree College in accordance with the prevailing Government policy and prescribed norms and procedures.

- c) It is further stated that a proposal for introduction of Science and Commerce streams at Jagannath Singh College was received from the Principal of the College on 10.07.2026. Upon receipt of the proposal, the Government promptly initiated the prescribed process by issuing Office Order No. E-805331/8 dated 10.07.2026 (**Annexure-E**) directing the Inspector of Schools, Cachar District Circle, to conduct an inspection and submit a detailed report regarding the feasibility of introducing the proposed streams.

The proposal shall be processed further on receipt of the inspection report and examined in light of the availability of requisite infrastructure, qualified faculty, laboratory and library facilities, student enrolment potential and other norms prescribed by the Government and the competent regulatory authorities.

Further, for expansion of Higher Secondary education, the Government has issued Office Memorandum No. E-493670 dated 12.07.2024 (**Annexure-F**) prescribing the policy and eligibility criteria for introduction of additional streams in existing Higher Secondary Schools.

Accordingly, if any Higher Secondary School within the Udharbond Legislative Assembly Constituency fulfils the prescribed criteria and satisfies the conditions laid down in the aforesaid Office Memorandum, necessary steps shall be initiated by the Government for introduction of Science and/or Commerce streams, subject to administrative feasibility, availability of budgetary provision and observance of the prescribed norms and procedures.

OFFICE MEMORANDUM
Policy on Upgradation of Upper Primary School to High School

The Department of School Education has observed that a significant number of students drop out during transition from Elementary level to Secondary level. One of the key reason is the fragmented School system where a student on completion of class VII has to shift and take admission in a High School. Studies reveal that this disruption in the education journey is one of the major reason of large number of dropouts during transition. Another reason is that there are lesser number of High Schools in comparison to Elementary Schools in the State.

To address the issue of drop out, the Department of School Education, in tune with the New Education Policy laid stress on having a single cohesive educational unit of a wholesome school from Class 1 to Class XII to provide a more holistic flexible education and significantly reduce the drop out and achieve the goal of meaningful education to all.

Focus shall be on upgrading the Upper Primary Schools (ME Schools) in the State to High Schools and Higher Secondary Schools on need based criteria. Goal setting shall begin with the upgradation of the Stand Alone ME School to High School.

A uniform criteria is therefore stipulated for upgrading the Upper Primary Schools to Secondary Schools as stated below;

1. To consider an ME School for upgradation to High School the following points need to be justified :
 - i) There should not be any pending proposal of amalgamation for upgradation of the ME School to High School.
 - ii) There should not be any High School within the radius of 5 KM from the ME School.
 - iii) The ME School having adequate enrollment and pass percentage may be considered for upgradation to High School.
 - iv) The School should have minimum required area of land for construction of building etc., to accommodate the students.
 - v) The ME School must have additional classrooms available to accommodate the students of Class IX and X.
 - vi) The ME School must have sufficient existing teaching staff having Graduate Degree (B.A. and B.Sc.) available to take Classes IX and X. In case of Schools eligible for other conditions mentioned above and there is a shortage of teachers for required upgradation, concerned Inspector of Schools may rationalise teachers from other Institutions to fulfil the shortage of teachers having requisite qualifications.(The required posts of Graduate Teacher in the upgraded High Schools will be created with abolition of equal nos. of non-essential posts.)
2. The Inspector of Schools, the District Elementary Education Officer and the Block Elementary Education Officer in joint sitting with the Head of the Institution, SMC and the teaching staff, shall make an assessment and evaluation of the M.E. School and prepare a proposal with proper justification for its upgradation, to be submitted to the Directorate of Secondary Education, Assam.
3. The Directorate of Secondary Education, Assam shall duly examine whether the proposal fulfils all conditions above, whether the proposal is authentic and state his/her justification for accepting or rejecting the proposal and shall submit the eligible proposals to the Government. The Director Elementary shall view the proposal in the online file and shall countersign the proposal for reference.
4. The Department shall reserves the right to disallow the Upgradation based on the assessment of the proposal and further enquiry and verification through its own sources/mechanism. Further the Department reserves the right to order for discontinuation of the functioning of the newly upgraded Section at the end of certain academic session if the above conditions are not fulfilled or the performance is found to be dissatisfactory.
5. After receiving approval from the Government, the Director of Secondary Education, Assam shall issue necessary order of upgradation.

6. The Directorate of Secondary Education shall furnish the copy of the Order of Upgradation to the Directorate of Elementary Education and MD SSA for record modifications.
7. The Assam State School Education Board, Div.-I shall take necessary action for recognition/affiliation of the ME School as High School also take follow-up action for registration of Students of Class IX and X as per existing procedures and norms.
8. The category of the School shall be updated from ME School to High School in the UDISE Portal under Samagra Shiksha, Assam, in coordination with the District Mission Coordinator.
9. The schemes and policies of Samagra Shiksha, Assam pertaining to the Elementary section shall continue to remain applicable in the upgraded High Schools.
10. Thereafter, the Director of Secondary Education, Assam, shall submit the proposal to the Government for creation of Post of Headmaster/ Assistant Headmaster/ Graduate Teacher/ Junior Assistant/ Grade IV including the proposal for construction of required number of Classrooms, purchasing of desk, bench, table, chair etc., within 01 (one) month from the date of issue of order of upgradation of the School.
11. The conditions for recruitment of the posts of Headmaster/ Assistant Headmaster/ Graduate Teacher/ Junior Assistant/ Grade IV of newly upgraded High Schools shall be as per the existing Service Rules framed by the Government.
12. Further, if any upgraded High School is feasible for upgradation to Higher Secondary School, the Inspector of Schools shall duly examine and submit proposal for Upgradation of the School to Higher Secondary School as per existing norms.
13. Any ME School that does not come under the purview of the above mentioned criteria shall be amalgamated with nearby High School/Higher Secondary School as per guidelines of "Shiksha Khetra Scheme".
14. Any ME School/ UP School that does not have the resources or logistics to fulfil the criteria for upgradation but there is a need to upgrade, the Directorate shall move the proposal with data based justification and financial implications to the Department. The Department with the approval of the Authority shall move Finance Department for concurrence for creation of Post and infrastructure funding etc.
15. The services of all Teaching and Non Teaching Staff in the upgraded School shall come under the purview of the Directorate of Secondary Education.
16. The Proposer(School Management, District authorities) shall certify that there is no financial implication in terms of manpower, infrastructure and logistics.

OFFICE MEMORANDUM

Dated Dispur the 11th January, 2023

E-244416/8 :In view of the necessity of delinking Higher Secondary sections from the Colleges of Assam under the National Education Policy (NEP) 2020, it has become essential to increase the intake capacity of Higher Secondary sections in the schools of State. The Govt. of Assam has already decided to upgrade 1000 High Schools (HS) to Higher Secondary Schools. Further, it has also become essential to open additional stream(s) in existing HSS on need basis.

To upgrade existing HS to HSS and introduction of an additional stream(s) in existing HSS, the following criteria should be followed:

- 1. Enrolment of the existing High School:** There should be adequate enrolment in class X. The enrolment shall be a minimum of 40 in the respective stream and shall facilitate minimum 10 numbers in each subject of the desired streams.
- 2. Infrastructure:** Minimum required infrastructure must be available to accommodate the students. Considering the time constraint, repairing and renovating the existing structure may be undertaken.
- 3. Feasibility Report by the AHSEC:** The permission for up-gradation shall be allowed on receipt of the Feasibility Report from the AHSEC. The AHSEC issues Feasibility Report after observing some procedures as per their regulations that shall have to be issued before up-gradation.
- 4. Selection of Streams:** There are four streams viz—Arts, Science, Commerce and Vocational under AHSEC. The selection of the stream should be based on available infrastructure requirements. Science stream may be opened in schools, where Laboratories and other facilities are available.
- 5. Selection of optimum number of Subjects:** AHSEC permits 83 subjects in Higher Secondary first year. Since the number of teachers shall be limited at present, limited subjects are to be offered in these upgraded HSS. The number of subjects may be allowed in newly up-graded HSS as per the availability of Teachers in the existing High School and nearby schools.
- 6. Requirement of teaching staff:** The existing teachers of High Schools having requisite educational and professional qualifications shall be entrusted to take HS classes in addition to their regular classes in view of the Government OM No E-250079/1 Dated 12.12.2022.
- 7. Introduction of another stream in the existing School:** If it is considered necessary to introduce another stream in the existing HSS, the above criteria shall be adopted. Besides, the prospect of admission of students in the new stream shall be scrutinized so that at least 40 students shall be available for admission. In the case of the Science stream, it should be carefully ascertained the availability of the Laboratory and other facilities in the existing school.

8. Initially, only provisional approval would be accorded, and the department shall assess the sustainability of the up-gradation for three to five years based on enrollment in the up-graded streams. Once sustainability is established, the department will examine the feasibility of the creation/up-gradation of posts for those streams.

For up-gradation and introduction of an additional stream(s), the School authority should JUSTIFY the following points:

- (a) The school authority should clarify why the up-gradation has been proposed.
- (b) Shall clarify how they will manage teachers without the creation of posts and recruitment.
- (c) How they will manage the additional infrastructure requirements.
- (d) How they have calculated the requirement of minimum 40 students and 10 for each subject in the respective stream shall be admitted.

E-493670: Considering the employment opportunities in different sectors and the NEP 2020 prescribing a multidisciplinary approach in education, there is a growing opinion for making multiple streams available in government-run higher secondary schools. In consideration of this, some Schools have volunteered and proposed opening new streams, mobilising their own resources.

Further, students' performance in the Class X final examination has improved, leading to a higher pass percentage, and there are demands from all quarters for the opening of other streams in the existing higher secondary schools in the State.

The Department, in response, duly examined the matter and its consequential effects. It is found that while there is a growing demand for the introduction of new streams in a particular School, there is a reduction in enrolment in some streams of another higher secondary School, leading to excess teachers in some streams in a particular higher secondary School. At the same time, teachers' requirements for new streams can be mobilised from the pool of excess teachers.

The Department also observed that candidates with higher qualifications have secured positions as Teachers at the Graduate level through recruitment, and hence, qualified teachers with postgraduate degrees are available who can volunteer to teach in higher secondary classes.

The Department is also of the view that the demands for additional streams are assumptive in nature, and placing Teachers by creating posts without enrolment is not desirable.

The Department further opines that, in a few cases, the issue of introducing new streams can be resolved by merging or amalgamating schools.

Therefore, after considering all the aspects related to the opening of new streams, the Department of School Education is pleased to lay down the following criteria for the introduction of new streams.

(#). CRITERIA TO BE FULFILLED FOR SCHOOLS UNDER GOVERNMENT VOLUNTEERING FOR OPENING OF NEW STREAMS IN HIGHER SECONDARY SCHOOLS.

1. **Justification Note:** Any School that proposes and volunteers to introduce a new stream shall take the following steps:
 - i. The Joint Committee, comprising the Inspector of Schools, the SMDC, and the Teaching staff, should jointly sit and draft the proposal addressed to the Director of Secondary Education. The

meeting shall be chaired by the Inspector of Schools, and the Head of the Institution shall be the Member Secretary.

- ii. The proposal shall state in a maximum of 25 words why the said school has no scope for amalgamation or merger as per the Shiksha Kshetra Scheme and provide **valid reasons for opening** new streams.
- iii. The SMDC shall conduct a peripheral survey of the adjoining habitation where the prospective students reside and analyse the number of households, targeted age-group availability, etc. A one-page report shall be submitted.
- iv. The **proposal** shall contain the names of the probable students.
- v. The proposal shall state the last three years' previous flow of students from the habitation/enlarged habitation to the adjoining other schools of higher secondary level, both private and government, and why the continuation of such flow is not desirable.

2. **Requirement of teaching staff:** There must be a minimum of three qualified Government/Provincialised Teachers in the School eligible and competent to teach in the proposed other stream of the higher secondary classes. The Proposer (School) shall furnish the consent of the available qualified teachers in its School who shall voluntarily impart Classes in the proposed new streams in addition to the present/existing classroom room assignments.
3. **Enrolment of the proposed Higher Secondary Class XI of the High School:** A minimum of 30 to 40 students are expected to or have consented to admission in the proposed new stream (name of the prospective students). A copy of the consent paper shall be annexed.
4. **Infrastructure:** The proposal shall state the minimum sufficient infrastructure to start with the new stream, stating the number of classrooms, blackboards, desk benches, fans-lights, room fitness and adequate outdoor spaces (total open sq feet adjoining the classrooms within the premises) that is available or the source and timeline of making it available to accommodate the prospective new students along with the previous enrolled students
5. **Feasibility Report by the AHSEC:** The Proposer shall submit the views of the AHSEC on the feasibility of opening new streams (The AHSEC shall do their exercise in accordance with the Regulation of the AHSEC).
6. **Selection of Streams:** There are three streams, viz. Arts, Science, and Commerce or others. Under the present perspective of requirements in each of the streams, the School (Proposer) shall state the availability of supporting infrastructures for Laboratories and project rooms in the Schools and the source of providing the facilities and equipment in such infrastructures.
7. **Selection of optimum number of Subjects:** There are 83 subjects in Higher Secondary first year. The Proposer (School) shall propose the combinations of subjects in the respective streams that are proposed to be offered linked to its physical and qualified teaching manpower availability.
8. **Rationalisation/Conversion of the existing Post.** The Proposer, assuming that the new stream shall be running successfully for three consecutive academic years and thereafter, shall state whether there is any available vacant post in the School which can be rationalised and converted to meet the requirement of post for the new stream in due course of time.

9. **The Director of Secondary Education shall duly examine whether the proposal fulfils all the conditions above, whether the proposer's submission is authentic, and state his/ her justification for accepting or rejecting the proposal.**
10. **The Department reserves the right** to disallow the opening of the new streams based on the assessment of the proposal and further enquiry and verification through its own sources/ mechanism. Further, the Department reserves the right to order for discontinuation of the functioning of the new stream at the end of a certain academic session if the above conditions are not fulfilled or the performance is found to be dissatisfactory.
11. **Consequent upon the closure of the new stream,** in the event a new post is created and a teacher/teachers are posted, the said teacher/ teachers with the post shall be rationalized and shifted to another need-based school within the vicinity/ District/State.
