About SRS

The Sample Registration System (SRS) provides reliable annual estimates of Infant Mortality Rate, Birth Rate, Death Rate and other Fertility & Mortality Indicators at the National and sub-National levels. It is a large-scale demographic survey conducted every year by Office of the Registrar General of India in all States/Union Territories.

Abstract

This Bulletin presents the estimates of Birth Rate, Death Rate, Natural Growth Rate and Infant

Mortality Rate (IMR) for the year 2024 for India and its States/Union Territories. The 'Bigger States/Union Territories' in this Bulletin are those having population more than 10 million as per Census, 2011.

In 2024, the Birth Rate for the Country has been estimated at 18.3, whereas the Death Rate has been estimated at 6.4. The estimate of Infant Mortality Rate for the year 2024 is 24 infant deaths per thousand live births.

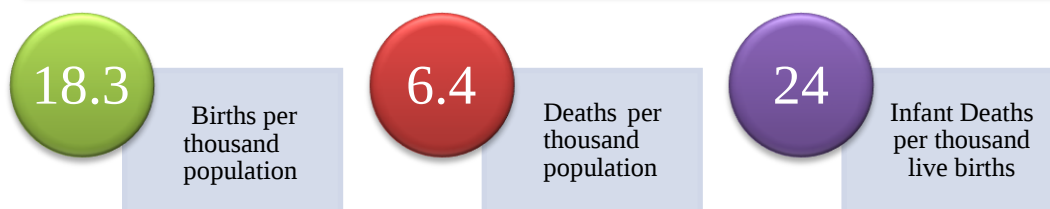


Figure 1: India at a glance, 2024

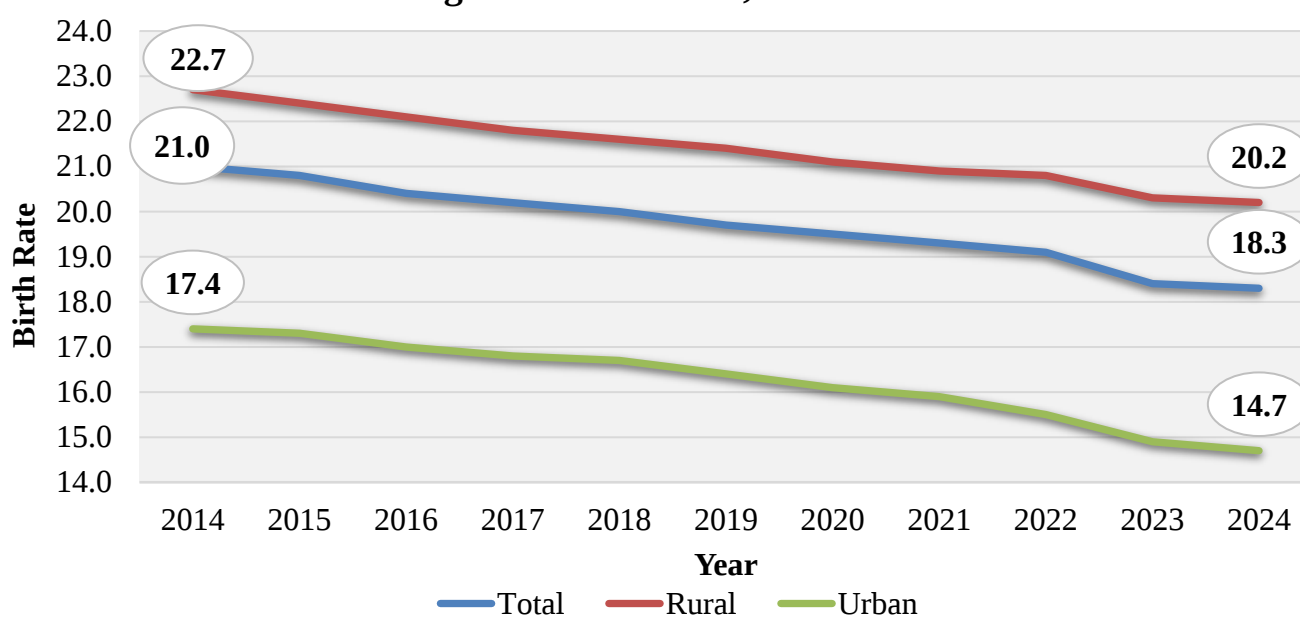
Birth Rate

Birth Rate is a crude measure of fertility of a population and is a crucial determinant of population growth. It gives the number of live births per thousand population in a given region and year.

The Birth Rate at all India level has declined drastically over the last five decades from 36.9 in 1971 to 18.3 in 2024. The rural-urban differential has also narrowed over these years. However, the Birth Rate has continued to be higher in rural areas compared to urban areas in the last five decades. *Figure-2* below shows the level of estimated Birth Rate for India over the period of 2014-2024. Birth Rate has declined by about 13% in the last decade, from 21.0 in 2014 to 18.3 in 2024. The corresponding decline in rural areas is 22.7 to 20.2 (about 11% decline) and for urban areas, it is from 17.4 to 14.7 (about 16% decline).

In 2024, the highest Birth Rate has been observed at 26.8 in Bihar, whereas Andaman & Nicobar Islands has the lowest Birth Rate of 9.9.

Figure 2: Birth Rate, 2014-2024



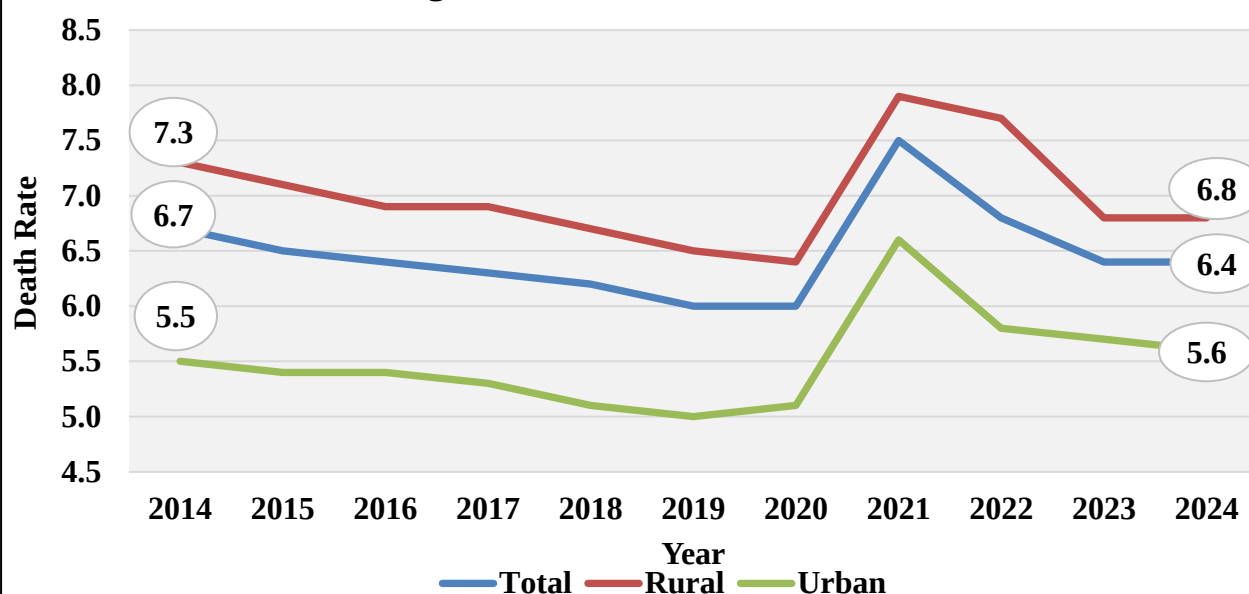
In 2024, Chhattisgarh has recorded the highest Death Rate of 8.4, whereas the lowest Death Rate has been recorded in Chandigarh at 3.9.

Death Rate

Mortality is one of the basic components of population change and the related data is essential for demographic studies and public health administration. The Death Rate is one of the simplest measures of mortality and is defined as the number of deaths per thousand population in a given region and time period.

The Death Rate in India has witnessed a gradual decline over the last five decades from 14.9 in 1971 to 6.4 in 2024. The Death Rate for rural areas for the year 2023 & 2024 remains same at 6.8. There is a relative decrease in urban areas from 5.7 in 2023 to 5.6 in 2024. The following *Figure-3* indicates the Death Rate at rural, urban and all India level for the period of 2014-2024.

Infant Mortality Rate

The Infant Mortality Rate (IMR), which is widely accepted as a crude indicator of the overall health scenario of a country or a region, is defined as the infant deaths (less than one year) per thousand live births in a given time period and for a given region.

The present level of IMR (24 infant deaths per thousand live births, for the year 2024) is less than one-fifth as compared to 1971 (129 infant deaths per thousand live births). In the last ten years, IMR has witnessed a decline of about 38%. The Figure-4 given below indicates that IMR at all India level has declined from 39 to 24 in the last decade. The corresponding decline in rural areas is 43 to 27 (about 37% decline) and in urban areas from 26 to 17, (about 35% decline). Despite the decline in IMR over the last decades, one in every 42 infants die within first year of their life at the National level (irrespective of rural- urban).

In 2024, the maximum IMR has been reported in Chhattisgarh (36) and the minimum in Manipur (2).

Figure 4: Infant Mortality Rate, 2014-2024

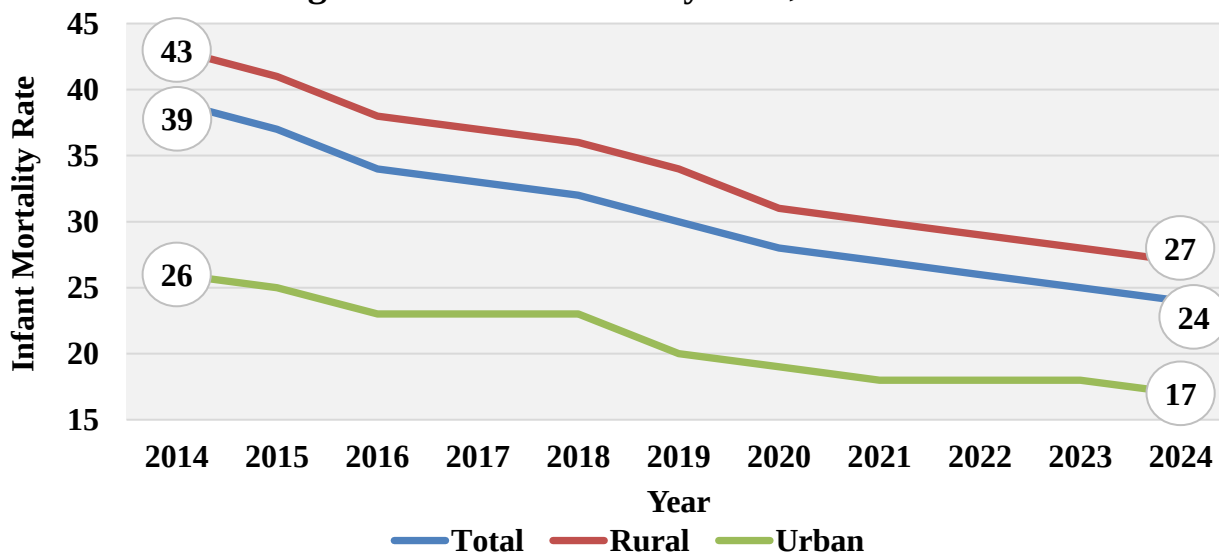
