Will the Minister of Indigenous & Tribal Faith & Culture Deptt. be pleased to state:

- (a) The total population of Scheduled Tribes (STs) residing in Dispur Constituency, along with community-wise details (Bodo, Karbi, Mising, Rabha, Tiwa, Deori, Sonowal Kachari, Dimasa, etc.) as per the latest available records.
- (b) Kindly furnish the details of schemes and projects implemented by the Indigenous and Tribal Faith & Culture Department and other departments for the socio-economic upliftment of tribal communities in Dispur Constituency during the last five years.
- (c) Kindly furnish the amount of funds allocated and utilized under various tribal welfare schemes in Dispur Constituency during the last five years.

Answer

The Minister of Indigenous & Tribal Faith & Culture Deptt., Sri Biswajit Daimary, will answer :

- (a) As informed by the Tribal Affairs (Plain) Department, Constituency wise and Community wise details of ST population is not available with the Department. However, as per Census of 2011, the total ST population of Kamrup (Metro) district is 75,121.
- (b) No Schemes and projects have been implemented by Indigenous and Tribal Faith & Culture Department for the socio-economic upliftment of Tribal Communities in Dispur Constituency during the last five years.

However, with the objective of preserving and promoting the spiritual organizations and places of worship of the Indigenous and Tribal Communities of Assam, as well as supporting cultural events and ceremonies, Grants-in-Aid have been provided under the SOPD-G scheme since the Financial Year 2023–24.
