#### **SKILL, EMPLOYMENT & ENTREPRENEURSHIP DEPARTMENT**

The Departmentally Related Standing Committee on Development (D) Departments took Grant No. 35 incorporated in the Budget which was presented to the House on 10<sup>th</sup> July, 2026 for the Financial Year, 2026-27 for consideration.

1.1. Assam Skill Development Mission (ASDM), as the nodal agency for skill development in Assam, is working under the aegis of Skill, Employment & Entrepreneurship Department, Government of Assam. ASDM provides quality skill training for gainful employment of unemployed youth, to encourage development of entrepreneurs in different sectors and to create a skills ecosystem for convergence of quality skills training. ASDM was formed in December, 2015, and it started Skill training from December, 2017.

## **2.4 DIRECTORATE OF EMPLOYMENT & CRAFTSMEN TRAINING, ASSAM**

The Directorate of Employment & Craftsmen Training, Assam has two wings namely –

(A) Employment Wing:

**(A) Employment Wing:-** The **Employment Wing** of the Directorate has a network of 52 nos. of Employment Exchanges spread across the state of Assam. The Employment Exchanges work under the ambit of the National Employment Service (NES) Manual along with National Career Service for delivery of services like Registration of Jobseekers, Vocational Guidance & Career Counselling, Employment Market Information, Peripatetic Survey, Enforcement and Implementation of **Employment Exchanges (Compulsory Notification of Vacancies) Act, 1959** which have now been subsumed into the **Code on Social Security, 2020**. There are **15,43,350 nos. (as on 30<sup>th</sup> June 2026)** jobseekers registered in the Employment Exchanges of Assam through Online Registration system in Sewa Setu Portal.

Three services are available in Sewa Setu Portal—i) Registration, ii) Re-registration and iii) Renewal of Registration

In order to address the issues and challenges faced by the Employment Sector, a comprehensive overhauling of the working of the Employment Exchanges for enhancing employability through Employment Services and systematic Career Counselling & Vocational Guidance Programme are undertaken.

Notable major achievements of the Employment Wing of the Directorate of Employment & Craftsmen Training, Assam are: -

### **Mega Career Counseling Programme cum Career Fair:**

- **Career Counselling Programme-** In the year 2025-26, multiple career counselling sessions were conducted across 26 districts, benefiting more than 10,500 candidates.
- **Zonal Exhibition of Career Courses -** Zonal Exhibitions on Career Courses were organized across six zones in Assam, covering over 6,200 candidates.
- **Recruitment Drive FY2025-26**—In the Financial Year 2025–26 (from 1 April 2025 to 20 December 2025), a total of 20 recruitment drives were conducted across 10 districts of Assam, with participation from 40 employers. Of the 2,519 candidates who participated, 508 were shortlisted and 232 were selected.
- **Employers Conclave:** On 4th March 2025 DECT, Government of Assam organized an Employers Conclave with participation from around 70 employers, start-ups, PSUs, and Government departments to strengthen employer engagement and promote employment initiatives.

### **> Setting up of Model Career Centres (MCC) under National Career Service (NCS):**

The Government has given great importance to Career Counselling and Vocational Guidance in order to equip the unemployed youth with relevant career information and also to enable the aspiring youth to make career decision/choice. To achieve this objective, 12 (Twelve) nos. of Model Career Centres have already been set up under the National Career Service Project.

**National Career Service Project (Mission Mode Project for Inter linking of Employment Exchanges**

> ***The scheme aims to upgrade the infrastructure across all Employment Exchanges and to enable our region's youth to connect with employers all over the country. An amount of Rs. 31,877,988.00/-was utilized for procurement of IT Infrastructure (Computer, Printer etc.) and Refurbishing items under this scheme for 44nos of Employment Exchange (under the General and Hill Area).***

A) Registration of Applicants in Employment Exchanges through online mode

The Govt. of Assam has completely discontinued the manual process of registration of Job seekers and started online registration services for jobseekers through <https://sewasetu.assam.gov.in/portal> w.e.f 27<sup>th</sup> September'2021. There are **15,43,350 nos. (as on 30<sup>th</sup> June 2026)** jobseekers registered in the Employment Exchanges of Assam through Online Registration system in Sewa Setu Portal. Three services are available in Sewa Setu Portal – i) Registration, ii) Re-registration and iii) Renewal.

a) Assam Job Portal

## **OBSERVATIONS & RECOMMENDATIONS**

### **Grant No.35**

#### **Skill, Employment & Entrepreneurship Department**

After a great deal of careful consideration of the papers/documents submitted by the Skill Employment & Entrepreneurship Department and clarification made by the Departmental representatives during the course of tendering their oral evidence the Departmentally Related Standing Committee (DRSC) on Development (D) Departments has made the following Observations and Recommendations.

During the meeting, the Committee thoroughly discusses the recommendation No.5 of its 2<sup>nd</sup> Report and came to know that the Assam Skill Development Mission (ASDM) submitted a proposal to the Department of Tea Tribes and Adivasi Welfare, Govt. of Assam for the implementation of the Short-Term skill training programme belonging to the Tea Tribes Community across 67 Jagannath Community.

**Therefore, the Committee reiterates the recommendation and directs the Department to take early initiative for implementation the scheme at the earliest.**

The Committee makes the observation during the meeting that 2,112 beneficiaries were selected under “Anuprerana” schemes for the full-time research scholar or full-time Divyang research scholar enrolled in a Government or public institute located in Assam only.

**The Committee, therefore, recommends that the Department should take up the matter to provide the facility who studies outside the State also.**

After a threadbare discussion on the matter of Establishment of ITI’s with the departmental representatives, the Committee has been appraised that at present though there are 150 ITI’s in the system of Government, Semi-Government and PPP models in the State, but most of the block yet left out to set up ITI.

**Therefore, the Committee strongly recommends that every block should have one ITI. and Department should confirm to ensure job guarantee those who have completed the course in ITI’s centres.**

The Committee discusses the recommendation No.2 in its second report regarding the instructors of the ITIs and the Department informed the Committee that due to retirements of instructors many posts are laying vacant for which affecting the smooth functioning of the ITIs though 89 nos. of junior instructors were recruited in February, 2026.

**Keeping in mind the importance of the matter the Committee recommends to fill up the vacant posts in a systematic approach for the greater interests of the trainees.**

While the Committee deliberates with the departmental representatives the Committee observes that the tools and equipments of the various ITI's were procured long back.

**Therefore, the Committee directs the department to take necessary step for the procurement as well as up gradation of the tools & equipment.**

During the course of discussion with the Department the Committee is intimated that many of the ITIs are in dilapidated condition as such they need immediate renovation.

**Having understood the problem, the Committee recommends the Department to take up for allocation of sufficient fund for the renovation of the civil infrastructure of the concerned ITIs.**

**With these observations and recommendations as mentioned aforesaid, the Committee recommends that the Budget provision amounting to Rs. 49630.87 Lakh during the financial year 2026-27 under the Grant No. 35 be accepted.**

**The Action taken on the report may be submitted to the Committee within 90 (ninety) days from the date of presentation of the Report to the House.**
